Fr. Joe Kelly, a bedrock of the IPF family, wrote and published a book of his stories as a parish priest in New York. The book, "On Second Thoughts: A Book of Stories", is profound, humorous, and worth reading. Fr. Joe's 25+ year history with IPF is a common connecting point for many of our faculty, staff and supporters.

One of IPF's gemstones, Linda Antonelli, a long-time staff member, retired in February. Linda's work in both fundraiser and friend-raiser events, as well as her work with donations, has been a major stepping stone in raising awareness of IPF. Into the Life of Glory:

Fr. George Aschenbrenner, SJ

Fr. George Aschenbrenner, SJ, one of IPF's founders and long-time adjunct staff member, died on November 27, 2021, less than a week after his 89th birthday.

Fr. Aschenbrenner's early mission as a Jesuit focused mainly on guiding the candidates of the Maryland Province of the Society of Jesus as their novice master. One of the novices who entered the novitiate in those years was Fr. John Horn, SJ, another one of IPF's founders.


During those years, Fr. Aschenbrenner emerged as a leader in the search to recapture the original spirit and practice of the Spiritual Exercises of St. Ignatius Loyola. His groundbreaking writing on the "Consciousness Examen" breathed new life into the practice of the daily Examen Prayer, which had always been a vital component in the formation and life of religious women and men.

Providentially, a Jesuit provincial suggested that Fr. Aschenbrenner should turn his attention to also work with diocesan priests. This new focus found him journeying to Rome where he served for a term as Director of Spiritual Formation at the Pontifical North American College, the formation house for United States seminarians studying in Rome. Even after completing his time in Rome, he continued to offer retreats and conferences to priests in many dioceses.


In 1981, while speaking at a meeting of diocesan seminary spiritual directors, Fr. Aschenbrenner spontaneously put together some suggestions for a spiritual formation program that he hoped would impact the hearts and lives of diocesan seminarians. While carefully preserving the unique characteristics of diocesan priestly life and spirituality, as distinguished from that of monastic or religious priests, he called for a "kind of novitiate for diocesan seminarians." About ten years later, in conversation and prayer with the other IPF founders, those suggestions would be developed and realized in what became the Institute for Priestly Formation (IPF).

Fr. Aschenbrenner's proposals came to particular fruition in IPF's summer program of spiritual formation for diocesan seminarians. As that program began in 1995, Fr. Aschenbrenner developed his 1981 proposals into a course that he taught for many years in the summer seminarian program. The course eventually blossomed into a book published some years later entitled, *Quickening the Fire in Our Midst: The Challenge of Diocesan Priestly Spirituality*.

We pray together with his Jesuit brothers and all those who were touched by his example and teaching that, having served the "greater glory" of God throughout his life, he may be granted that life of glory for all eternity.









New Office Building

Unless the Lord builds the house, in vain do the builders labor. (Psalm 127)

For most of last year, 2021, we have been searching for new office space in Omaha. This past December, with the help of some benefactors and after taking out a loan, IPF purchased a modest one-story office building in Omaha. We are excited to be moving into our new location in April 2022 (11626 Nicholas Street, Omaha, NE 68154).

The decision that led to this was two-fold: First, our long-term strategic plan had several emphases: relational, programmatic, and structural. We wanted to maintain our presence in Omaha, have more independence over daily operations, and secure space for another full-time priest and additional development staff, as well as meeting/catering space, and a chapel for 35 people.

Secondly, our current office building on Creighton's campus is being repurposed by the University in May. Creighton has been exceptional in giving us office space on campus for decades. Creighton University is a key relationship in the history of IPF's growth and they continue to help in our transition by giving us ample time to find, and move into, our new office.

We will continue to host our summer programs at Creighton. The only difference is that our "home office" will not be on campus, but in the center of Omaha. For most people who know IPF, the change of offices will go unnoticed as all of our programs continue to operate as usual.

Finally, we are grateful to God for bringing together all the people who helped us in this office search.



Preparation for IPF's New Home Office in Omaha

- IPF participated in a year-long strategic study by an outside professional organization to map the future. It was recommended at the time to move off the Creighton Campus to further establish IPF as a national and locally independent organization.
- Creighton University gave notice that the Campion House was in need of repurposing and necessary time was given for IPF to relocate.
- A Building Committee was formed, and a real estate agent was selected. The Building Committee visited multiple properties.
- The Finance Committee conducted a comparison of other non-profits similar in size to IPF. Research was conducted as to IPF's financial sustainability, and the decision to buy, rent, or build a new office was examined.
- A consultation with the IPF Corporate Board took place.
 They reviewed the research of the Building Committee and gave approval to buy a building.
- The IPF Foundation Board was also consulted and presented with the research. They also gave approval to buy a building.
- A Capital Campaign to raise funds is underway and a loan to buy the building was secured.

For 28 years the Institute for Priestly Formation has been a financially independent 501(c)(3) corporation housed on the Creighton University campus in Omaha, Nebraska. In 2022, we began a new era for IPF with the purchase of a new home office in Omaha. By paying off the cost of the five year building loan, IPF will save approximately \$72,000 in interest the first two years and \$169,200 in interest and principal payments over the following three years. This would be a total savings of \$241,200 over five years.

Honoring the Memory of a Special Priest

Kate Brennan was never the same after that hot July night in 2008, when she met her IPF "Spiritual Son," Jorge Gomez-Alvarado, a seminarian from the Diocese of Tulsa. Kate had been invited to be part of a new Spiritual Moms program at IPF to pray for a seminarian son during his summer weeks at Creighton. She had been praying for Jorge every day since he came to Omaha.

When Kate arrived at Creighton for Friends Night, an evening when Spiritual Moms meet their spiritual sons for the first time, she talked with Jorge about her sorrow from her mother's death three months earlier. Jorge told Kate that his mother died years ago and he ached that she would not be at his ordination to give him her blessing. A special bond grew between them as they talked about missing their mothers.

At the end of the Friends' Night program, they continued to converse as Jorge walked Kate to her car.

When they got to the car, Jorge asked Kate to give him her blessing. Kate opened a bottle of Lourdes water she had brought as a gift for Jorge, anointing his head and hands while he knelt and bowed his head. Kate asked Our Lady to embrace Jorge with Her protection and blessings as he continued his journey to ordination and in his future priesthood. The special motherly blessing with the water from Our Lady of Lourdes solidified a bond between Kate and Jorge that continued beyond Friends Night.

Months, later, Kate and Jorge talked by phone. Jorge said he was still using the bottle of water from Lourdes to bless others -- and the bottle remained full. In 2011, Kate leaned that Fr. Jorge, the young seminarian she had prayed for and befriended, had been tragically killed in a car accident, just seven weeks after his ordination.

To honor his memory, Kate opened a St. John Paul II Fund for Priests account with the Institute for Priestly Formation in Fr. Jorge's name. Her goal was to fully fund the account honoring Fr. Jorge and IPF. That goal was reached in late 2021 and people from his diocese will receive it posthumously in 2022.





Remembering Fr. Patrick O'Kane

October 3, 1949 - January 2, 2022

Fr. Patrick O'Kane, a priest of the Diocese of Sioux City, Iowa, and a long-time adjunct faculty member/spiritual director of the Institute, died on January 2, 2022.

Fr. Pat first came to know about IPF when he was a member of the first group of participants in the Spiritual Direction Training Program. As he completed the program, he was invited to join the staff for the next round and many subsequent rounds.

Among many other pastoral assignments, Fr. Pat was the Superintendent of Schools for the Diocese of Sioux City for six years. As we began to engage in reviews of the summer program courses, he brought his experience in curriculum review to IPF, teaching us how to evaluate courses and to plan for their improvement and updating.

Fr. Pat served as a spiritual director in the summer seminarian program as well as a classroom instructor for IPF 502. The summer course integrates human and spiritual formation and serves as a way for seminarians to more deeply appreciate the gift of celibacy.

The latter years of Fr. Pat's life were marked by a series of long and difficult health challenges. These challenges necessitated he retire early from active diocesan ministry. As a result, he moved to Omaha to be near his doctors and, despite many difficulties, managed to live a life of great service to people in the Omaha area, as well as continuing to offer spiritual direction in IPF's summer program.

With deep gratitude, we commend Fr. Pat into the hands of Jesus, the Great High Priest, whom he served so generously throughout his many years of priestly life.










2021 IPF Foundation Revenues


2021 IPF Foundation Expenses




2021 IPF Revenues
