From the IPF Executive Director:

Dear Friends of IPF,

I was struck, recently, at the IPF Spiritual Direction Training Program for priests we host in Illinois at the University of St. Mary of the Lake, at how much our participants are renewed in their priesthood each time we gather. We meet for three weeks each year over a span of three years. The 160 priests in the program arrive on a Sunday evening, after a long day of travel from various points in the U.S. Many of them pastor multiple parishes. There is a sense of fatigue as they arrive. After a brief welcome, and going over logistics for the week, we begin the program. The priests are divided into smaller groups, and a staff member from IPF leads a brief prayer in each small group. Then each priest has the chance to express to his brothers a grace that he desires to receive from God during the week. I always find myself uplifted by their faith, honesty, and the plain language they use in speaking to God.

By the end of the week — Friday morning — we gather again with the priests in smaller groups. The weariness that was apparent on Sunday has been transformed into much laughter and a real sense of fraternity among the priests. An IPF staff member leads a brief prayer, and the priests have a chance to express to their brother priests what grace they received from God during the week. This has been the most impactful part of the program for me, to be a "fly on the wall" listening to how God works in the lives of these men. They return to their parishes ready for the next weekend's masses, often preaching and teaching on the topics they learned during our week together.

Our mission at IPF is to accompany seminarians and priests in deepening their spiritual lives so they may lead others to Christ. I am grateful for all who support the work of IPF. It is a testament to the faith you have in the priesthood and the work of IPF. This issue of our magazine is dedicated to all who support us, financially, spiritually, by your friendship and guidance.

Building a Foundation for the Future Recap

Timeline

November of 2021

- IPF found and purchased a building on 11626 Nicholas Street in Omaha, Nebraska.
- The silent phase of the Capital Campaign began.
- Anonymous donors provided IPF with \$1,503,900 used for half of the cost of the building as a down payment and a start-up budget to begin renovations.

February of 2022

- Demolition and renovation began.
 - March of 2022
- The Living Stones: Building a Foundation for the Future Capital Campaign kicked off.
- In this stage of the campaign, \$259,640 was raised with individual donations.
- A \$140,000 grant from an anonymous foundation for the renovation of the Chapel was received.
- Not included in this figure are the In-Kind Gifts to the project of \$5,084.

August of 2022

- The \$500,000 Matching Fund was launched as an incentive to complete the Campaign.
- **•••** \$293,392 was raised toward the Match.
- \$204,633 was pledged; \$69,665 has been collected and is included in the above figure. Not included in the figure is the \$134,968 in pledge payments yet to be paid.
- With total pledges and collected donations, IPF came close to meeting the Match.

January of 2023


\$500,000 was deposited into the Living Stones Capital Campaign by the IPF Foundation, completing the Match. \$36,950 was added to the Match in pledges and individual gifts toward the campaign for a total of \$540,795.

IPF has partnered with NCDVD for many years to serve diocesan vocation directors in strengthening their own interior lives. Fr. Rafferty offers daily meditations at their National Convention. IPF staff and adjunct staff offer workshops on prayer and discernment.

At the heart of this partnership is a silent, directed retreat offered to the vocation directors. As they come to experience the Lord in new and deepening ways, they are strengthened in their own relationship with God, become more discerning on standing firm in their identity, and are then better able to be free to serve those who come to them.



Jim and Brett are very welcome additions to the IPF Foundation Board, and we are most grateful for their expertise and service.


New Faces on the IPF Bishops Council

Bishop Thomas Daly (Diocese of Spokane)

Bishop Ronald A. Hicks

Bishop Ronald A. Hicks (Diocese of Joliet)

Bishop Ronald A. Hicks is the sixth bishop of the Diocese of Joliet, where he was installed in September 2020. He was ordained an auxiliary bishop of the Archdiocese of Chicago in 2018, where he had served as vicar general since 2015.

He earned a Bachelor of Arts degree in philosophy from Niles College of Loyola University in Chicago and both his Master of Divinity degree and his Doctor of Ministry degree from the University of St. Mary of the Lake in Mundelein. He was ordained a priest for the archdiocese in 1994 and served as an associate pastor at parishes in Chicago and its suburbs, before being called to serve as dean of formation at the former St. Joseph College Seminary in Chicago; as regional director of Nuestros Pequeños Hermanos (NPH) in Central America, which oversaw the care of more than 3,400

abandoned and orphaned children; and as dean of formation at Mundelein Seminary.

Bishop Hicks serves on the Committee on Clergy, Consecrated Life and Vocations for the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops. He also serves on the board of the Catholic Extension Society and the Mundelein Seminary Advisory Board.

Bishop David L. Toups was ordained and installed the sixth bishop of the Diocese of Beaumont, Texas on August 21, 2020. George and his brother, Msgr. Esseff, jointly authored a book, Brothers and Fathers, which chronicled the intertwining lives of these two brothers and their unique ways of living out the gift of fatherhood. George and his wife, Rosemary, raised four children, who brought eleven grandchildren into the world, who in turn gave George and Rosemary twenty great-grandchildren. For his part, Msgr. John has been a spiritual father to countless individuals on many continents.

The Institute and all those associated with the IPF mission have been blessed by the faith, love, and generosity of this man of God. May the Lord grant him the reward of a good and faithful servant!






